

EVERGREEN

MATERIALS LIST

Wreaths are a cherished part of Christmas décor, used to welcome guests and bring festive cheer to homes. Decorative Christmas wreaths are usually made of evergreen leaves, holly, mistletoe...and don't forget fabric even better.

In this workshop we will be creating a holiday quilt using a variety of rich and dramatic green and red fabrics. The ribbon border adds a wonderful touch to this quilt. Lots of tips and tricks for perfect piecing. Join us for a fun, informative, festive day to create your unique Christmas quilt.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN READ INSTRUCTIONS COMPLETELY!!!

A ¼ inch seam allowance used throughout. Check the accuracy of your seam allowances before you begin.

You will be given a complete pattern in class. This is a new pattern by Sew Society and has not been released yet.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Yardage requirements are given in yard units. Use a variety of fabrics to total the yardage given to achieve the rich and interesting mixture. A great pattern to use scraps.

Background and Borders - 2 1/2 yards

Wreaths – scraps or yardage to total 1 ½ yards

Bows – ½ yard

Backing 4 yards

Binding – ¾ yard

Note: We will be using a lot of 2 ½” squares so a jelly roll could be used for part of your yardage.

WREATH BLOCK –

There are a total of 112- 2 ½” squares finished and one 6 ½” block in each wreath block.

Each block has” 40 white 2 ½” squares

25 green 2 ½” squares

15 red 2 ½” squares

Each block has: 12 green and green half square triangles (two green fabrics)

12 green and white half square triangles

4 red and white half square triangles

4 red and green half square triangles.

CUTTING OUT BEFORE CLASS:

We will be making one wreath block in the workshop. If you can cut out the 2 ½” squares (the amount is listed above) before class in the various colors that would be extremely helpful for you.

1- 6 ½” square in background fabric. This is the center of each wreath block.

We will cut the half square triangles in class. We have a technique to make them perfect every time.

If you have a nice batting scrap 24 x 24 bring it. It works really well to put your block together on and also to transport if you have any uncompleted block.

SUPPLIES:

- Sewing Machine
- Sewing Machine cord
- Rotary Cutter, Mat
- 6 ½” Square
- Thread (to match or use beige/cream or gray)
- Pins or Wonder Clips
- Sharp Fabric Scissors
- And whatever else you feel you may need.
