

Feathers Supplies

The Feathers quilt, first published in 2013, is one of the original and most beloved Alison Glass patterns. Co-authored with Nydia Kehnle, Feathers is a classic Alison Glass block design with a lot of possibilities. This new 2021 version includes a gallery of quilts to illustrate options and provide inspiration. The Feathers pattern uses paper piecing to create the blocks. It includes 14 block templates and detailed instructions with full color illustrations.

The finished quilt is 55" x 66" but is easily modified by adding or deleting rows and/or columns

REQUIRED PATTERN:

Feathers by Nydia Kehnle and Alison Glass

MATERIALS FEE:

\$10.00 payable to the Instructor in class for pre-printed paper piecing templates.

RECOMMENDED RULER:

Add-A-Quarter Plus in either the 6" or 12" size

NOTE: If you have the old style Add-A-Quarter Ruler that is fine.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

2-1/2 Yards **TOTAL** Fabric for Feathers

25 to 40 Prints for color gradation shown on pattern. Fat eighth bundles provide a variety of fabrics in a size that works well with the templates.

Feathers is also a good project for scraps.

4 Yards Background

4 Yards Backing

1/2 Yard Binding

GENERAL SUPPLIES:

Rotary Cutter

Rulers, 6" x 24" Recommended **OR** Your Favorite

Thread in Neutral Shade for Piecing and Construction (Aurifil is my favorite)

New Needle, Size 80/12 Sharp (recommended) **OR** Your Favorite

Straight Pins (I like the Clover Patchwork ones)

Seam Ripper (I like the Clover one)

Hera Marker (optional) a Wooden Iron or Bone Folder will also work

Open Toe Foot (optional), helpful for the paper piecing

1/4" Foot (seam allowances on this project are 1/4")

Sewing Machine in Good Working Order

Sewing Machine Bobbins, Power Cord, Foot Pedal, and Manual

POSSIBLE USEFUL ITEMS:

Small Cutting Mat

Small Iron

Small Pressing Surface
