

Hot and Heavy Iron Caddy Supply List

This tote will hold your iron when you travel and when you're ready to iron open the tote and it becomes a convenient pressing surface. Now, when you're ready to go home from your class or retreat you can place the hot iron on the pressing surface, fold up the sides of the pressing surface, fasten the sides and you are protected from the hot iron.

Fashionable and cute, these spacious zippered bags in two sizes will hold a variety of items or your favorite mini or regular-sized household iron. Each features a zippered pocket on front and a mesh divider and fabric slip pocket inside. Rings attached to the handle may be used to attach a separate strap. An easy-to-make Cord Wrap handle contains cords and can be made with leftover fabrics and interfacing from the project.

There are two sizes available: Small - 7" H x 10-1/4" W x 5-1/2" D (for popular mini irons) and Large - 9-1/2" H x 13-1/4" W x 7" D (for most regular-sized irons).

Coordinating Fabric (Binding, Handles, Inner Back Slip Pocket)	5/8 yard	1 yard
Soft and Stable, 58" (Body Stabilizer)	1/2 yard	1 yard
Fusible Interfacing	1/4 yard	3/8 yard
Mesh Fabric (Inner Front Slip Pocket)	3" x 17"	5" x 21"
Fold Over Elastic, 20mm	1 yard	1-1/4 yards
Handbag Zippers, Single Slide	1 each 24"	1 each 24"
Handbag Zippers, Double Slide	1 each 30"	1 each 40"
1" Polypro Strapping	2 yards	2-3/8 yards

1" D-Rings or Triangle Rings	2 rings	2 rings
Base Stabilizer	5" x 8-3/4"	5-3/4" x 12"
Can be clear acrylic, corrugated plastic, or heavy cardboard.		
3/4" Hook and Loop Tape	2-3/4"	2-3/4"

GENERAL SUPPLIES:

Rotary Cutter (45mm recommended) and Your Favorite Ruler
 Hera Marker (optional)
 14-In-1 Measuring Gauge (optional, but highly recommended)
 Cotton Thread in Neutral Shade for Piecing and Construction
 Decorative Thread to Coordinate or Contrast for Top Stitching
 New Needles (Size 80/12 Sharp are my favorite)
 Straight Pins (I like the Clover Patchwork Pins)
 Seam Ripper (I really like the Clover one)
 1/4" Patchwork or Quilting Foot (optional, highly recommended – seams are 1/4")
 Stitch In The Ditch Foot (optional, highly recommended for top stitching)
 Zipper Foot
 Walking Foot (for optional Quilting of main body and lining)
 Sewing Machine in Good Working Order
 Sewing Machine Bobbins, Regular Sewing Foot, Power Cord, Foot Pedal, and Manual
