

# Little Quilts Squared Supplies

Little Quilts Squared is a fun calendar collection made with Woolies flannels to keep up and change out year round. Use machine applique techniques to make these adorable 12" finished quilt squares. Hang them individually or put them together for a full calendar quilt.

## **MATERIALS:**

Little Quilts Squared Calendar Series Kit (Any month)

Fusible web (Like Gentle Fuse or Heat n Bond Lite) (at least 1-1/2 yards)

## **GENERAL SUPPLIES:**

Fabric Scissors **AND** Paper Scissors

Applique pressing sheet

Marking pen or pencil

Thread (any neutral thread should be fine, I like Aurifil thread)

If you have specialty threads you wish to try, bring them along.

Seam Ripper (I like the Clover one)

Straight Pins (I like the Clover Patchwork pins)

New Needles (I like Size 80/12 Sharp)

Open Toe Foot (optional, but great for doing appliqué stitching)

Having your various machine feet is also useful.
