

Nest Collage Supplies

This is part of a collection called “Whatevers!” Whatevers! are 8” x 8” college blocks that you can turn into runners, potholders, tiny quilts or continue making the designs for a larger college quilt! If you have ever wanted to do one of Laura Heine's college Quilts this is the perfect class to ‘get your feet wet’ and try the process on a small, simpler design.

REQUIRED PATTERN:

Whatever! No. 58 Nest Collage Pattern by Laura Heine for Fiberworks

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

NOTE: Be creative with your fabric choices!

3/4 to 1 Yard of 12” wide Steam-A-Seam II (paper-backed fusible web)

9” Square for Background Fabric

4” x 6” of 9 different fabrics for the Nest

6” Square for Base of Nest

Fabric to make 3 Small Eggs

GENERAL SUPPLIES:

Rotary Cutter and Small Cutting Mat

Ruler, 6" x 24" **OR** Your Favorite Ruler

Appliqué Pressing Mat

Pencil for tracing Applique Designs

Pressing Mat and Small Iron can be very helpful

Small, Sharp Scissors for cutting the applique shapes

Thread in Neutral Shade for Piecing and Construction (Aurifil is my favorite)

New Needle, Size 80/12 Sharp (recommended) **OR** Your Favorite

Straight Pins (I like the Clover Patchwork ones)

Seam Ripper (I like the Clover one)

Hera Marker (optional) a Wooden Iron or Bone Folder will also work

1/4" Foot (seam allowances on this project are 1/4")

Sewing Machine in Good Working Order

Sewing Machine Bobbins, Power Cord, Foot Pedal, and Manual
