

# New Leaf Supplies

This is a fun table runner great for a Spring or Summer picnic table. The curves are gentle and easy to stitch. Have fun mixing fabrics for a fun project.

**REQUIRED PATTERN:** New Leaf by Karla Alexander for Cut Loose Press

**FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:**

12 Light Value Rectangles - 9-3/4" x 11-1/2"

12 Medium Value Rectangles - 9" x 10-1/2"

1/8 Yard Medium Green (sashing in the middle)

Backing and Binding: 1-1/2 Yards

**RECOMMENDED RULER:**

Ovals Always, No. CGRKAOVAL by Creative Grids

Highly recommended but arcs can be cut without but MUCH easier with the ruler.

**GENERAL SUPPLIES:**

Rotary Cutter

Rulers, 12-1/2" x 12-1/2" Square Recommended

Thread in Neutral Shade for Piecing and Construction (Aurifil if my favorite)

New Needle, Size 80/12 Sharp (recommended) **OR** Your Favorite

Straight Pins (I like the Clover Patchwork ones)

Seam Ripper (I like the Clover one)

Hera Marker (optional) a Wooden Iron or Bone Folder will also work

1/4" Foot (seam allowances on this project are 1/4")

Sewing Machine in Good Working Order

Sewing Machine Bobbins, Power Cord, Foot Pedal, and Manual

**NOTE:** You will be working with bias so using Best Press or your favorite starch on your fabric is a good idea.
