

Pin Cushions Supplies

These Pin Cushions are a modern version of a vintage household accessory. Have fun with them using scraps of fabrics from your favorite sewing projects and embellishing them with buttons or beads. These can make great gifts for your quilting and sewing friends.

REQUIRED PATTERN:

Choose your favorite from below or bring one of your own.

Pieced Pincushions by Susan Gower for Indygo Junction

Pollo Loco by Carrie Nelson for Miss Rosie's Quilt Co.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Check the fabric requirements listed on your chosen pattern, most just need scraps although if you're wanting coordination a few fat quarters can be helpful

1/4 Yard of Pellon Shape Flex – Used to back your pin cushions so the filler doesn't come through the fabric.

PIN CUSHION FILLER:

Ground Nut Shells by Plum Easy Patterns – These are my favorite although I have used fine sand also. Both give a nice weight to your pin cushion.

GENERAL SUPPLIES:

Rotary Cutter

Rulers, 6" x 24" Recommended **OR** Your Favorite Ruler

Thread in Neutral Shade for Piecing and Construction (Aurifil if my favorite)

Applique Press Sheet

New Needle, Size 80/12 Sharp (recommended) **OR** Your Favorite

Straight Pins (I like the Clover Patchwork ones)

Seam Ripper (I like the Clover one)

Hera Marker (optional) a Wooden Iron or Bone Folder will also work

1/4" Foot (seam allowances on this project are 1/4")

Sewing Machine in Good Working Order

Sewing Machine Bobbins, Power Cord, Foot Pedal, and Manual
