Quilty Gifts (2) Supply List

General Supplies:

- Sewing machine in good, working condition, including:
 - Manual
 - Power Chord
 - Foot Pedal
 - Bobbins
 - Coordinating Thread
 - New, Sharp Needle
 - ¼ 'Sewing foot
- Fabric scissors
- Rotary Cutter
- Rulers
- Cutting mat (No Larger than 18" on any side)
- Seam Ripper
- Small pressing surface and iron
- Pins
- Binding clips
- Fabric Pencil/Marker

For the Pillowcase,

You will use 3 fabrics: Fabric A (cuff), Fabric B (trim), and Fabric C (body). Depending on your preferred cuff length, choose **ONE** of the following sizes:

- Standard/Queen with a 9 inch cuff:
 - \circ A $\frac{1}{4}$ yd B $\frac{1}{8}$ yd C $\frac{3}{4}$ yd
- Standard/Queen with a 12 inch cuff:
 - \circ A $\frac{1}{3}$ yd B $\frac{1}{8}$ yd C $\frac{2}{3}$ yd
- King with a 9 inch cuff:
 - A ¼ yd B ½ yd C 1 yd
- King with a 12 inch cuff:
 - A ½ yd B ½ yd C ½ yd

For the Tote Bag,

There is some flexibility for you to choose how you wish to make your bag. For example, you can make it with canvas or quilting cotton, with or without a liner, and straps with webbing or fabric. You could also add stabilizer to make a stiffer bottom.

I made mine with canvas outside, a quilting cotton liner, and webbing straps. (No Stabilizer, because I tend to crumble mine up when they are not in use.)

- Outside ⅔ yd (or 1 yd, if you are using for straps too)
- Liner (Optional, but recommended) ⅔ yd
- Straps (if not using fabric:) Webbing 1 inch wide, 2 yards
