

## Rambler Bag supply list

This messenger-style bag is sure to become a wardrobe staple! It's the perfect size for everyday life and features a large flap secured by a pretty flower-shaped magnetic snap, as well as an inner pocket, adjustable crossbody strap, and a convenient handle. Learn how to work with flex foam, add pockets and hardware to this stylish little bag.

**Pattern: Rambler Bag Workshop** by Karen Pratt (Kit version has all the required hardware)

### Fabric Requirements:

- Flap fabric - Fat quarter
- Inner Pocket - Fat quarter
- Body fabric - 1/2 yard
- Lining fabric - 1/2 yard
- Bag straps and tabs - 1/2 yard
- 1 yard of woven iron-on interfacing like SF101
- 1/2 yard of fusible foam (non-fusible works too. We will quilt the bag)

### Other tools and supplies:

- Thread snips
- Thread to match or contrast your fabrics
- Polyester thread to hand sew the sides together
- Ruler with rotary cutter and mat (12"x18" or 18"x24" is fine)
- Pre-wound bobbins (or wind your own)
- Machine needles size 90/14
- Straight pins and sewing clips
- Water soluble or heat erase pens (I recommend **Frixion pen** for light fabrics and the **clover white marking pen CLO517** for dark fabrics)
- Sewing machine capable of straight and zig-zag stitching
  - You will need a standard sewing foot (or clear foot) and zipper foot
  - Walking foot is helpful, but not required
- Chopstick or stiletto (purple thang works too)
- Seam ripper or small sharp scissors
