This handy zip-up Tool Case stores and carries rotary cutters, scissors, and more. A variety of easy-to-access pockets in vinyl, mesh, and quilted fabric can be customized to fit the tools you use and love! The finished project is 9-1/2" High x 12-1/2" Wide x 1-1/2" Deep (12-1/2" High x 20-1/2" Wide when open).

REQUIRED PATTERN: Running with Scissors from ByAnnie

REQUIRED FABRIC AND SUPPLIES:

| ByAnnie's Soft and Stable (stabilizer for case/tote) | 36" x 58" |
| Fusible Interfacing (I like Pellon Shape Flex SF101) | 7" x 12-1/2" |
| Mesh Fabric (inner pockets) | 4" x 13-1/2" |
| Vinyl (inner pockets) | 12" x 12-1/2" |
| 2 Each 30" or longer Double-Slide Handbag Zippers | |
| 1 Each 40" or longer Double-Slide Handbag Zipper | |
| (these are wider and heavier than regular zippers) | |
| Polypro Strapping, 1" wide | 3/4 Yard |
| Fold-Over Elastic, 20mm wide | 3/4 Yard |

GENERAL SUPPLIES:

Rotary Cutter and Ruler (your favorite)
Hera Marker, Two In One Tool, Wooden Iron, Point Turner, Bone Folder For pre-pressing seams before using the iron. Optional but helpful.
Thread for Stitching (my favorite is Aurifil)
Contrasting and/or Coordinating Thread for Top Stitching
New Needles (my favorite are Microtex (Sharp) Size 80/12 or with Aurifil 70/10)
Straight Pins (I like the Clover Patchwork ones)
Seam Ripper (I like the Clover one)
Small Wonder Clips may be useful
Seams are 1/4" so you'll want the foot you use to stitch this accurately Zipper Foot Sewing Machine in Good Working Order Sewing Machine Bobbins, Regular Sewing Foot, Power Cord, Foot Pedal, Manual

<u>NOTE</u>: You may wish to bring your extra feet as one of them might be helpful in the process.

CLASS PREPARATION:

If you feel comfortable cutting out your pieces prior to class it will save you time during class. Be sure to identify each piece you Cut to make it easier when you are ready to start stitching.
