

Scrappy Tote Bag supply list

This scrappy and fun tote bag is fully lined with boxed corners and interior pockets! It is beginner friendly and fun to make! A great way to use up those impulse bought 5" precut packs or use up scraps from your last project.

Finished size is approx. 17" wide x 17" tall x 3" deep

This bag is traditionally pieced with straight seams and top stitching. No paper piecing or templates required. Great for confident beginners and beyond.

Fabric Requirements:

- (1) 5" pre-cut square pack (40-42 pieces)
- You can also use (8) fat eighths (9x21) or (32) 5" x 5" squares from scraps
- 5/8 yard cotton fabric for lining
- 1/2 yard cotton fabric for pockets and handles
- 2 yards of woven iron-on interfacing like SF101
- 5/8 yard of fusible fleece or batting

Other tools and supplies:

- Thread snips
- Thread to match your fabrics
- Fabric Scissors
- Ruler or measuring tape
- Pre-wound bobbins (or wind your own)
- Machine needles size 90/14
- Straight pins or sewing clips
- Sewing machine capable of straight stitching
 - 1/4" sewing foot
 - Standard sewing foot
