Surf Wave/Selkie Supplies

Surf Wave celebrates waves crashing upon the shore! There are two sizes in the pattern; one uses a Charm Pack (5" squares) and the other a Layer Cake (10" squares). The small size finishes at $32-\frac{1}{2}$ " x $33-\frac{1}{2}$ " and the large size finishes at $64-\frac{1}{2}$ " x $66-\frac{1}{2}$ ".

You may also choose to do the Selkie design (from a different company). Escape to the beach with our sea-glass inspired quilt! Selkie, with its beautiful sea-glass shades of blue and green, was inspired by rolling ocean waves. It's the perfect size to bring along to your favorite beach, or to snuggle up with and get lost in your favorite novel! This project is both Layer Cake (10"squares) or Fat Quarter friendly.

SURF WAVE FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Wave Prints	1 Charm Pack	1 Layer Cake

Background	1-1/4 Yards	3-1/3 Yards
Backing	1-1/4 Yards	4-1/4 Yards
Binding	3/8 Yard	2/3 Yard

SELKIE FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Assorted Prints 29 - 10" Squares **OR** 15 Fat Quarters

Low-Volume Background Prints 3-1/2 Yards Binding 5/8 Yards Backing 4-1/4 Yards

HELPFUL RULER: Highly Recommended

4-1/2" Half Square Triangle Bloc-Loc Ruler

NOTE: If you have any size of the Bloc-Loc ruler larger than 4-1/2" that will also work just as well.

GENERAL SUPPLIES:

Rotary Cutter and Your Favorite Ruler

Regular Sewing Thread in Neutral Shade to Blend with Fabric (I like Aurifil)

New Needles (80/12 Microtex/Sharp are my favorites)

Hera Marker, Wooden Iron, Bone Folder, Point Turner (optional but very helpful)

Straight Pins (I like the Clover Patchwork Pins)

Seam Ripper (I like the Clover one)

Fabric Marker (I like the SewLine and find I use the Pink and Green most)

1/4" Piecing Foot **OR** the foot you use to achieve this

Sewing Machine in Good Working Order

Sewing Machine Bobbins, Power Cord, Foot Pedal, and Manual

POSSIBLE USEFUL ITEMS:

Small Cutting Mat Small Iron

Small Pressing Surface

CLASS PREPARATION:

If you wish to get a head start on the class you could cut the following:

SURF WAVE:

See the bottom of page 1 of the pattern for selecting the squares from either your Charm Pack or Layer Cake.

From your background fabric cut 13 each 5" squares for the small quilt and 7 each 10" squares for the large quilt.

The remaining fabric cuts are for the large background areas and can be done later.

NOTE: Remember to cut your binding strips to **your** favorite width.

SELKIE:

Layer Cake: Just pick your favorite 29 squares. Fat Quarters or Yardage: Cut 29 each 10" squares.

Background Fabric: Cut 29 each 10" squares - 8 each 10" strips should yield

your

29 squares.

The 9 each 4-1/2" strips will be used after all your half square triangles are made and you are putting the blocks together so you may wish to do this later.

NOTE: Remember to cut your binding strips to **your** favorite width.
