

# The Collector Supplies

Jars and bowls sit atop the shelves in groups of prints and colors. A great pattern to 'bust' your stash with or choose a color theme. This is a traditionally pieced pattern. Victoria will show you easy techniques to achieve great folded corners! Finished size is 67-1/2" x 65"

## **REQUIRED PATTERN:**

The Collector by Robin Pickens Quilt Patterns

## **RECOMMENDED RULER:**

Mini Simple Folded Corners by Doug Leko for Antler Quilt Design

A very helpful ruler for the folded corner techniques used in this project.

## **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:**

Block Prints	20 Fabrics at least 9" wide x 21" long
You could use a Layer Cake for a scrappy version or a total of 2-1/2 yards.	
Border	1 Yard
Sashing (Thin Inner Border)	1/4 Yard
Background	2-1/3 Yards
Backing	4-1/4 Yards
Binding	5/8 Yard

## **GENERAL SUPPLIES:**

Rotary Cutter and Your Favorite Ruler

Regular Sewing Thread in Neutral Shade to Blend with Fabric (I like Aurifil)

New Needles (80/12 Microtex/Sharp are my favorites)

Hera Marker, Wooden Iron, Bone Folder, Point Turner (optional but very helpful)

Straight Pins (I like the Clover Patchwork Pins)

Seam Ripper (I like the Clover one)

Fabric Marker (I like the SewLine and find I use the Pink and Green most)

1/4" Piecing Foot **OR** the foot you use to achieve this

Sewing Machine in Good Working Order

Sewing Machine Bobbins, Power Cord, Foot Pedal, and Manual

**POSSIBLE USEFUL ITEMS:**

Small Cutting Mat

Small Iron

Small Pressing Surface
