

Upscale Your Denim Jacket Supplies

Upscale your denim jacket using one of the three designs included in the pattern, each is constructed in columns using strip piecing techniques - no paper piecing or applique!

The designs in the pattern are Mountains, Stars, and Carpenter Star.

REQUIRED PATTERN:

Upscale Your Denim Jacket by Karen Abrahamovich

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

The amounts listed below are the number of 1" wide x width of fabric (salvage to selvage) strips needed.

Mountains:

Sky -	7 strips.
Mountain 1 -	2 strips.
Mountain 2 -	2 strips.
Mountain 3 -	2 strips.
Mountain 4 -	2 strips.
Clouds -	2 strips
Sun -	1 strip

Stars:

Background -	12 strips
Small Stars -	1 strip
Medium Stars -	1 strip
Large Stars -	1 strip
Heart -	1 strip

The amounts listed below are the number of 1-1/2" wide x width of fabric (salvage to selvage) strips needed.

Carpenter Star:

Background -	7 strips
Star -	2 strips

NOTE: The fabric requirements needed can be done from scraps - the longest pieces needed are 16-1/2" long except for the Mountains where the longest pieces are 8-1/2" long.

1 Each Fat Quarter for Facing
16" x 16" Lightweight Batting like Warm & Natural

GENERAL SUPPLIES:

Rotary Cutter and Your Favorite Ruler
Regular Sewing Thread in Neutral Shade to Blend with Fabric (I like Aurifil)
New Needles (80/12 Sharp are my favorites)
Hera Marker, Wooden Iron, Bone Folder, Point Turner (optional but very helpful)
Straight Pins (I like the Clover Patchwork Pins)
Seam Ripper (I like the Clover one)
1/4" Piecing Foot **OR** the foot you use to achieve this
Sewing Machine in Good Working Order
Sewing Machine Bobbins, Power Cord, Foot Pedal, and Manual

OTHER USEFUL ITEMS DURING CLASS:

Small Iron and Pressing Mat
Small Cutting Mat

CLASS PREPARATION:

If you wish to get a head start on the class you could cut the 1" strips ahead of time..
