

Delectable Supply List

While this design may look difficult, it is very easy and is a great project to use a Layer Cake pre-cut (10" squares). The quilt is designed to finish at 77" x 90-1/2" (finished block size is 7" x 8-1/2") but I believe it can be made to almost any size very easily - think about making it as a table runner or bed runner. My sample is much smaller at about 47" x 54". This project can also be made using all the same fabric in each block rather than mixing them all up.

REQUIRED PATTERN:

Delectable by Brenda Henning for Bear Paw Productions

REQUIRED FABRIC:

Main Fabric - Layer Cake precut of 40 squares (10" x 10" each)

OR use Scraps or Yardage to create 40 squares cut 10" x 10"

Background Fabric – 3-1/4 Yards

Accent Fabric – 1 Yard (for Inner Border and Binding)

Outer Border **PLUS** One 10" Square – 2-3/4 Yards (borders are cut lengthwise with this yardage). A 6-1/2" wide border you'd use almost this much fabric if it was cut in crosswise strips and there would need to be several seams.

Backing – 5-3/4 to 6 Yards

GENERAL SUPPLIES:

Rotary Cutter, Cutting Mat, and Ruler

9-1/2" Square Ruler (very helpful for trimming the blocks)

Thread for Stitching (I like Aurifil in a neutral color)

New Needles (my favorite is Size 80/12 Sharp)

Straight Pins (I like the Clover Patchwork ones)

Seam Ripper (I like the Clover one)

Seams are 1/4" so you'll want the foot you use to stitch this accurately

Sewing Machine in Good Working Order

Sewing Machine Bobbins, Regular Sewing Foot, Power Cord, Foot Pedal, Manual

NOTE: If you decide you want to get a head start I recommend that you **DO NOT** cut your blocks diagonally prior to stitching. Please contact me with questions.
