Fabric Requirements

One panel (2/3 yard) Panel-CD3680 Multi

³/₄ yard Bug-CD3689 Midnight

¹/₃ yard Fleur-CD3685 Blue

¹/₄ yard Fleur-CD3687 Green

1/4 yard Fleur-CD3687 Cobalt

1/8 yard Fleur-CD3686 Yellow

¹/₈ yard Texture-CD3688 Grey

¹/₂ yard Fleur-CD3687 Blue (binding)

2³/₄ yards backing fabric your choice

 $47" \times 67"$ batting

Cutting

From Panel-CD3680 Multi:

• Trim panel to $20^{1/2}$ " × $40^{1/2}$ ".

From Bug-CD3689 Midnight:

• Cut five $4^{1}/2^{1}$ × width-of-fabric (WOF) strips. Sew strips together end to end. Sub-cut two $4^{1}/2^{1}$ × $50^{1}/2^{1}$ strips and two $4^{1}/2^{1}$ × $38^{1}/2^{1}$ strips.

From Fleur-CD3687 Green and Fleur-CD3687 Cobalt:

• Cut four $1^3/4^{"}$ × WOF strips. Sub-cut two $1^3/4^{"}$ × $40^1/2^{"}$ strips, two $1^3/4^{"}$ × $20^1/2^{"}$ strips, and eight $1^3/4^{"}$ × $3^{"}$ strips.

From Fleur-CD3685 Blue:

• Cut three $3" \times WOF$ strips. Sub-cut two $3" \times 40^{1/2}"$ strips and two $3" \times 20^{1/2}"$ strips.

From Fleur-CD3686 Yellow:

• Cut one 3" × WOF strip. Sub-cut four 3" squares.

From Texture-CD3688 Grey:

• Cut one $1^3/4^{"} \times WOF$ strip. Sub-cut sixteen $1^3/4^{"}$ squares.

From Fleur-CD3687 Blue:

• Cut six $2^{1/2}$ " × WOF strips for binding.

Quilt Top Assembly

All seam allowances are 1/4" and pieces are sewn right sides together.

1. Sew a $1^3/4^{\circ} \times 40^{1/2}^{\circ}$ CD3687 Green strip to one side of a $3^{\circ} \times 40^{1/2}^{\circ}$ CD3685 Blue strip. Sew a $1^3/4^{\circ} \times 40^{1/2}^{\circ}$ CD3687 Blue strip to the other side of the $3^{\circ} \times 40^{1/2}^{\circ}$ CD3685 Blue strip. Make a total of two Unit 1, each measuring $5^{1/2}^{\circ} \times 40^{1/2}^{\circ}$ (*figure 1*).

Unit 1 Make 2.

2. Sew a $1^3/4^{\circ} \times 20^{1/2}^{\circ}$ CD3687 Green strip to one side of a $3^{\circ} \times 20^{1/2}^{\circ}$ CD3685 Blue strip. Sew a $1^3/4^{\circ} \times 20^{1/2}^{\circ}$ CD3687 Blue strip to the other side of the $3^{\circ} \times 20^{1/2}^{\circ}$ CD3685 Blue strip. Make a total of two Unit 2, each measuring $5^{1/2}^{\circ} \times 20^{1/2}^{\circ}$ (*figure 2*).

Unit 2 Make 2.

3. Sew a $1^3/4^{\circ} \times 3^{\circ}$ CD3687 Green strip to one side of a 3" CD3686 Yellow square. Sew a $1^3/4^{\circ} \times 3^{\circ}$ CD3687 Blue Strip to the other side of a 3" CD3686 Yellow Square. Make a total of four Unit 3, each measuring $5^{1}/2^{\circ} \times 3^{\circ}$ (*figure 3*).






Unit 3 Make 4.


4. Sew a $1^3/4$ " CD3688 Grey square to each end of a $1^3/4$ " × 3" CD3687 Green strip. Make a total of four Unit 4, each measuring $5^1/2$ " × $1^3/4$ " (*figure 4*).




5. Sew a $1^3/4^{\circ}$ CD3688 Grey square to each end of a $1^3/4^{\circ} \times 3^{\circ}$ CD3687 Blue strip. Make a total of four Unit 5, each measuring $5^1/2^{\circ} \times 1^3/4^{\circ}$ (figure 5).



6. Sew a Unit 4 to the top of a Unit 3. Sew a Unit 5 to the bottom of the Unit 3 to create Unit 6. Make a total of four Unit 6, each measuring 5¹/₂" square (*figure 6*).



7. Sew a Unit 6 to each end of a Unit 2, noting the orientation of Unit 6, to create Unit 7. Make a total of two Unit 7 (*figure 7*).



- 8. Sew a Unit 1 to each side of the Panel, noting the orientation. Sew a Unit 7 to the top and another to the bottom of the Panel.
- 9. Sew a $4^{1}/2^{11} \times 50^{1}/2^{11}$ CD3689 Midnight strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew a $4^{1}/2^{11} \times 38^{1}/2^{11}$ CD3689 Midnight strip to top and another to the bottom of the quilt top.

Finishing

- 10. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing, and quilt as desired.
- 11. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
- 12. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
