Fabric Requirements:

Small bag:

1 fat quarter main fabric

1 fat quarter lining

Large bag:

1/2 yd. main fabric

1/2 yd. lining

Medium bag:

3/8 yd. main fabric

3/8 yd. lining fabric

Notions:

Mesh

Fold Over Elastic

Zipper

Bosal

Cutting Out:

Cut out the following pieces before class.

Small (24" Zipper)

Main Fabric

9 1/2" high x 11 1/2" wide (Body) (After quilting: 8 1/2" high x 10 1/4" wide)

4 1/2" x 4 1/2" (Base)

Lining

9 1/2" high x 11 1/2" wide (Body)

4 1/2" x 4 1/2" (Base)

7 1/2" high x 2 3/4" wide (Gusset)

7 1/4" high x 13 1/2" wide (Bias Binding)

2" x 3 1/2" (Finger Loop)

Mesh

4 3/4" x 11 1/4" (Body Pocket)

Fold over elastic

11 1/4" (Body Pocket)

Bosal

9 1/2" x 11 1/2" (Body)

4 1/2" x 4 1/2" (Base)

Medium (36" Zipper)

Main Fabric

12 1/2" high x 17 1/2" wide (Body) (After quilting: 11 1/2" high x 16 1/2" wide)
6 1/2" x 6 1/2" (Base)

Lining

12 1/2" high x 17 1/2" wide (Body)
6 1/2" x 6 1/2" (Base)
10" high x 3 3/4" wide
11 1/8" high x 17 1/2" wide (Bias Binding)
2" x 4 1/2" (Finger loop)

Mesh

6 1/2" x 17 1/2" (Body Pocket)

Fold Over Elastic

17 1/2" (Body Pocket)

Bosal

12 1/2" x 17 1/2" (Body)
6 1/2" x 6 1/2" (Base)

Large (40" Zipper)

Main Fabric

15 1/2" high x 17 1/2" wide (Body) (After quilting: 14 1/2" high x 16 1/2" wide)
6 1/2" x 6 1/2" (Base)

Lining

15 1/2" high x 17 1/2" wide (Body)
6 1/2" x 6 1/2" (Base)
12 1/2" high x 3 3/4" wide (Gusset)
11 1/8" high x 17 1/2" wide (Bias Binding)
2" x 4 1/2" (Finger Loop)

Mesh

7 1/2" x 17 1/2" (Body Pocket)

Fold Over Elastic

17 1/2" (Body Pocket)

Bosal

15 1/2" x 17 1/2" (Body)
6 1/2" x 6 1/2" (Base)

Preparation:

Place the Body lining on a flat surface with right side down. Align the Body Bosal on top of the lining. Align the Body Main fabric with right side up on top of the Bosal. Clip around the edges. Stay stitch around the edges to hold the layers in place. Quilt. Using the same method, quilt the base layers. We will cut them out in class.

Supplies needed:

- Flipping Out pattern
- Fabric marking pens
- Sewing machine with feet (Bring all your feet and we will find the one that works best)
- Thread to match
- #80 or #90 machine needles
- Clips
- Scissors
- Seam Ripper
- Awl
- Rotary cutter with a good blade
