STRIPS AHOY. Cute name for a quick and easy quilt made with 2-1/2" strips! **Trish's** sample takes advantage of the bright colors in Kaffe Fassett's fabrics to make this eye-catching project. It would look equally striking in softer colors if that's your preference. This is a great project for beginning quilters or anyone who just wants to make something fun! (Finished size: 52" x 68")

You will quilt your fabric before class.

SASHIKO—THE ART OF JAPANESE HANDSTITCHING. Our resident handwork expert, Jane Ewald, is anxious to share her love of all things Sashiko with our customers. Using simple stitches preprinted on your choice of navy or white fabric, a spool of cotton thread, and needles, you will complete four small 4-inch squares. These can then be used as coasters or in a table topper/wall hanging like Jane's sample.

BASICS OF QUILTING. If you want to learn quilting from the very beginning, this class is for you! **Jeanne** is an expert at teaching the basics of quilting and after attending four sessions, you will leave with a finished quilt! In the first class, you will learn to cut your fabric using a rotary and ruler and stitch a perfect ¼” seam while constructing your quilt blocks. You will add borders and complete your quilt top in the second class. The third class will be all about stitching your backing, batting, and quilt top together to prepare for the last class—applying your binding. There will be homework between each class, but we promise you’ll be excited to start another project once this one is finished! You have your choice of a morning or evening class.

Put it on fabric for a decorator pillow or a canvas frame to hang on the wall. **Ida Mae** used fabric from **Anna Maria Horner’s** new line, “Hindsight”, for her butterfly. Again, no sewing machine required!!

Her trademark large florals and bright colors offer lots of possibilities. Using **Marti Michell’s** Log Cabin Ruler makes the cutting out process much easier. So does the fact that we have put together kits for those taking the class! (Finished size: 60” x 60”)

Well, as luck would have it, Moda has reprinted the fabric, the pattern is still available, and we will not miss out again! The whimsical blocks in this quilt contain all the usual Halloween characters—the witch’s hat and broom, pumpkins, bats, black cat, and even a bubbling caldron. We thought it would be fun to do this project as a four-week class like we do “Basics of Quilting”. You can come to one class or all four (and get one FREE!). (Finished Size: 58” x 65”)

(Finished size: 51” x 70”)

Well, **Kay** has taken three fabrics—light, medium, and dark—to make this adorable baby quilt. She promises you will leave the class with a completed top ready to quilt!

GUIDELINES FOR CLASS SKILL LEVEL

Beginner:	Little or no sewing experience.
Confident Beginner:	Knows how to thread a sewing machine, wind a bobbin, and maintain ¼” seams. Comfortable with using a rotary cutter and ruler.
Intermediate:	Has pieced and completed 2 – 3 quilts. Understands squaring up, nesting seams, binding, etc.
Advanced:	Has mastered more complex piecing techniques while completing at least 6 – 10 quilting projects.

CLASS POLICIES

We want to provide interesting and informative classes at reasonable prices. To do this, we ask your cooperation with the following:

1. Classes will be filled on a first come, first served basis, so we encourage you to sign up early. Classes that do not fill with a minimum of four people seven (7) days prior to the class may be subject to cancellation. As soon as a class fills, we will do our best to schedule another class for those on our waiting list.
2. Classes can be booked on the website (www.stitchersplayhouse.com) or in person. Payment of the class fee is due and payable at the time your reservation is made. Should you need to cancel your reservation, the class fee is refundable if we receive your cancellation seven (7) days prior to the class. Or you may apply it to another class or receive store credit.
3. At the time of registration, you will be given a list of supplies needed for your class. We ask that these supplies be purchased at **Stitcher's Playhouse**. You will receive a 10% discount on all items used in class as well as any other items purchased on the day of your class.
4. Some classes may **require prep work** before class or **homework** between classes. Failure to do the work may result in your class project not being completed within the allotted time. At the teacher's discretion, extra instruction time may be provided **at additional cost**.
5. No children are allowed in the classroom while a class is in session.
6. Classes will begin **PROMPTLY**. Please arrive early enough to be set up and ready to start at the scheduled time. We want to give you every minute of your class!
7. All classes except Basics of Quilting require knowledge of a sewing machine and basic sewing skills.
