Class Description

You've pieced it. You've quilted it (or *someone* has). Now you're ready to finish this puppy!! Come learn how to make binding and bind a sample quilt using your sewing machine (as well as some hand stitching) and have it turn out beautifully!

You will bring a small, quilted piece and some binding fabric to use during class. We recommend using something other than a "real" project so you can do all of your learning on a quilt that isn't meant to be an heirloom. ;)

Skill level

Beginner: However, you should know how to use your sewing machine before coming to class.

What does class fee include?

Class fee covers instructor and facilities costs only. Pattern and project supplies need to be purchased separately before class. Please note that there may be some prep work to complete so give yourself enough time to do that prior to class.

Please complete before first class

Gather all supplies and quilt sample pieces (keep it super simple or practice your quilting skills!).

Required supplies

- 2 small quilted pieces that measure about 18" x 11" (does not have to be precise). You can quilt two fat quarters together (with batting between the layers), then cut down the middle to make two pieces about that size. Please do not worry about making this exact size.
- 1/4 yd of fabric (or one fat quarter) to use for binding
- Thread (we prefer 50wt, but bring what you have)
- Sewing machine in good working order (remember your power cord and foot pedal)
- 1/4" foot
- Topstitch/edgestitch foot (if you have one)
- Walking foot (if you have one)
- Rotary cutter
- Quilting ruler (we will have some at the shop for you to use, and we can also recommend good rulers to purchase)
- Clips or pins (we love Wonder Clips)
- Standard sewing supplies (thread snips, seam ripper, machine needles, hand sewing needles, etc.)
