## Class Description

The Flying Geese Quilt block is simple, versatile, and quick to make. This class covers making a Baby or Throw size Artwork Quilt top. This pattern is great for showing off beautiful large print fabric and takes a break from tiny pieces. While working through the pattern in class, students will learn about four at-a-time flying geese. Students will also learn to master the scant quarter inch for the accurate piece, managing large pieces of fabric, and nesting seams. You will walk away at the end of class with a beautiful quilt top.

## Skill level

Confident Beginner. You should be familiar with basic quilting knowledge (¼" seam, piecing), has made a "simple" quilt top, and is ready to take on flying geese blocks.

## What does class fee include?

Class fee covers instructor, facilities costs. Class kit and project tools need to be purchased separately before class.

## Please complete before first class

- Purchase pattern - can be found at Treelotta
- Read through all pattern instructions before starting.
- Pick baby or throw size and pick two-color version or four-color version
- Purchase fabric (Check out my blog post for tips and tricks.
- Create a mock-up with QuiltInk.
- Prep fabric (wash if desired (I rarely pre-wash fabric, only if hand died, or backing with flannel or Minky)
- Iron fabric (spend time getting the more prominent creases out)
- Optional: cut fabric\*

\* **Cutting fabric note:** if you feel comfortable and want more sewing time in class, follow the pattern cutting instructions. We will spend time cutting some fabric in class and walk through my favorite tips. At a minimum, we will cut the following fabric pieces in class:

1 - A1	1 - C2
2 - B1	16 - D2
8 - C1	2 - D2

## Required supplies

- Artwork Pattern
- Fabrics A – D
- Sewing machine in good working order (don't forget power cord and foot pedal)
- ¼" foot
- Standard sewing supplies (thread, rulers, rotary cutter, pins, etc.)
- Marking Tool (Hera marker, pencil, or sewline fabric pencil)

## Optional

- Ruler with 45-degree line (to trim flying geese)  
at least 4" x 7.5" (if making baby size)  
at least 6.5" x 12.5" (if making the throw size)

## Mask Policy

Please bring your mask to class. While wearing a mask is optional at this point it is highly encouraged, and we are always willing to accommodate individuals who prefer that everyone masks up in class.
