



Beginner Quilting: Cutting & Piecing

Instructor: Marcia Salverson

Location: Treelotta (In-person attendance is assumed. Please let us know if you plan to join us via Zoom instead.)

Class Description:

This class is a perfect introduction to quilting! We will be teaching you to read and understand quilt patterns, fabric selections, cut your fabric, sew accurate quarter inch seams, assemble a quilt, and discuss how to put borders on a quilt. This is a great starter class and you can follow on in a series to finish your quilt top with straight line quilting and then binding!

Course Outline:

- Discussion of fabric choices and fabric values
- Instruction on reading and understanding patterns
- Instruction on methods for cutting fabrics
- Instruction on methods for pressing fabrics
- Instruction on methods for assembling a quilt
- Discussion of bordering quilts
- Problem solving

Skill level: Beginner, Students must have a basic knowledge of their sewing machine.

Please complete before first class:

- Please come to class with 6 fat quarters already chosen for your quilt top
 - 6 fat quarters in dark medium and light fabrics (2 dark, 2 medium and 2 light fabrics works best)
 - You're welcome to stop by the shop ahead of time to pick up the pattern included in your class price.

Supplies:

- [6" x 24 " ruler for blocks and ruler for cutting your fabrics](#)
- Sewing Machine – **in good working order.** Don't forget the power cord, foot pedal, and manual.
