

Intermediate Bagmaking: Foxboro Pouch

Center Street Quilts

Location: In-person attendance is strongly recommended as we have many supplies and tools for you to play with that will not be available to Zoom attendees.

Class Description:

Intermediate Bagmaking is designed for students who are ready for the next step after Beginner Bagmaking but aren't quite ready for our monthly bag classes. This session focuses on building confidence with core assembly skills, including installing zippers and managing more detailed construction.

You'll make the Foxboro Pouch by Center Street Quilts, a practical project that gives you structured practice with these techniques including making boxed corners and creating your own bias tape. This class is a good fit if you want guided support while moving toward more independent bagmaking.

Supplies:

- [Pattern](#) (purchased separately)
- See pattern for material requirements
 - Note:** you can use pre-made bias tape in place of the accent fabric. You will need 1 1/8, 1 1/4, or 1 1/2 yd of bias tape for the small, medium, or large, respectively.
 - Bring your scraps!
- Bag making tools:
 - [1/8" basting tape](#)
 - [Stiletto](#)
 - Optional:* 1.5"/18mm bias tape maker; available on its own or as part of a [set of bias tape makers](#)
- All your favorite sewing supplies (snips, pins/clips, removable marking tool(s) that will be visible on each of your fabrics, ...)
- Sewing machine in good working order
 - Bring your zipper foot!

Please complete before first class:

- Follow Cutting Instructions at the top of page 2 with the follow modifications:
 - If using pre-made bias tape in place of the accent fabric:** (see note under materials), cut to the lengths in the cutting instructions–the width will be the width of the bias tape
 - If using accent fabric:**
 - Change the width of the zipper tape from 1.5” to 3”
 - If you plan to make your own bias tape, do not sub-cut 1.5” pieces of accent fabric–e.g. cut one 1.5” x 24” (or longer) or two 1.5” x 12” (or longer) pieces of accent fabric that you will later (in class) cut into the lengths needed for the boxy corner and end bindings.
- Complete parts 1-3 of Prepare Quilted Panel
