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Gardening Apron

Fabric Collection – **Plant With Love**Finished Size – Approx. 12" x 18"
WOF = width of fabric
All seams sewn using ¼" seam allowance

Requirements:

Fabric A (Main) - 3/8 yd - 25219-10

Fabric B (Large Pocket) – 3/8 yd – 25224-76

Fabric C (Small Pocket) – 1/4 yd – 25220-32

Fabric D (Ties) – 1/4 yd – 9020-78 (Toscana)

Fabric E (Reverse Side) – 5/8 yd – DP25217-10

Medium Weight Fusible Interfacing – 7/8 yd

Instructions:

- 1. Cut the following:
 - 12" x 19" rectangles Cut one from Fabric A, one from Fabric E, and one from fusible interfacing
 - 8 %" x 19" rectangles Cut one from Fabric B, one from Fabric E, and one from fusible interfacing
 - $6" \times 19"$ rectangles Cut one from Fabric C, one from Fabric E, and one from fusible interfacing $3 \frac{1}{2}" \times WOF$ strips Cut two from Fabric D
- 2. Iron the fusible interfacing rectangles to the wrong side of the Fabric A, Fabric B & Fabric C rectangles.
- 3. To create the pocket pieces, layer the Fabric C and Fabric E 6" x 19" rectangles right sides together. Sew along the top edge, then flip it and press the seam. Top stitch 1/8" from the edge if desired. Repeat with the Fabric B and Fabric E 8 ½" x 19" rectangles. **NOTE:** The Fabric A and Fabric E 12" x 19" rectangles are not sewn together at this stage.
- 4. With right sides facing up, layer the Fabric C pocket piece on top of the Fabric B pocket piece, lining up the bottom raw edges. Pin in place.
- 5. Mark four pockets (3 seams) on the top (Fabric C) pocket piece, evenly spaced across the width. Sew along the two outer marked lines from the top of the Fabric C pocket piece to the bottom raw edge, leaving the center marked line unsewn at this stage.

- 6. With right sides facing up, layer the pocket piece on top of the Fabric A rectangle, again lining up the bottom raw edges. Pin in place. Sew along the center marked line from the top of the Fabric B pocket piece to the bottom raw edge.
- 7. Layer the 12" x 19" Fabric E rectangle on top of the apron pocket piece with right sides together. Sew the side and bottom edges. It is recommended that you use a walking foot for this stage, if possible.
- 8. Clip the two bottom corners to reduce bulk, then turn right side out and press the seams.

Finishing the Apron:

- 1. To make the apron ties, join the two Fabric D 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips end to end. Fold each end in $\frac{1}{2}$ ", then another $\frac{1}{2}$ " and press.
- 2. Fold strip in half, wrong sides together, along the length of the strip and press. Open and fold each side in to the center fold and press.
- 3. Slide the top raw edge of the apron piece into the folded strip, centering the strip at the center of the apron piece, and pin in place.
- 4. Sew along the entire length of the tie strip about 1/8" from the open edge, closing the tie and securing the apron piece in place.
- 5. Top stitch both ends and the top edge of the tie about 1/8" from the edges to complete your apron.
