Required Supplies

- Frame, interesting box, or some other found object that you would like to use as the base of your art piece
 (wooden box, a tin can, an old mantel clock, etc.). Approximately 8-12" would be an appropriate size, but
 that is up to you, of course! You will build your piece on this base. Thrift stores are a great source for these
 items. Keep the weight of the object in mind when you are selecting it.
- Assortment of found objects that may have interesting shapes: **hearts**, dolls, watch parts, gears, typewriter parts, hearts, bolts, pieces of old metal, straps of leather, fabric, spools, toys, bottle caps (plastic or metal)
- Synthetic paint brushes inexpensive is best. Bring an assortment of sizes (e.g. 1/2", 1" round, and a couple fine detail brushes: 1, 2, and 3).
- E6000 and Gorilla Glue (original formula)

Optional Supplies

- Acrylic paints (no oil or enamel) Golden, Liquitex, or Academy paints are highly recommenced, but any brand will work.
 - Colors: Transparent Red Oxide, Black Carbon, Pthalo Blue, Quinacridone Red, Dioxazine Purple, Nickel Azo Yellow, Pthalo Turquoise, Iridescent Gold and Silver
- Adhesives: DAP Kwik Seal (White): paintable latex caulk
- · Tools: Heat gun, Dremel, drill, screwdrivers, pliers
- Comfortable clothes that you don't mind getting paint, etc. on.
