# **Class Description**

Start your journey into fabric collage by starting with a nicely sized collage (about 18" x 24") and learn the basics of Laura Heine's beautiful collage technique while working on your choice from the Teeny Tiny Patterns. (Pattern sold separately) This class will teach you how to put together a collaged front and show you tools and techniques to make the process even more fun. We'll allow time to shop for fabrics on top of plenty of instruction and hands-on work.

By the time class is over, you should be close to complete and armed with information on how to finish up with a quilted mini-masterpiece.

You may attend in-person or via Zoom.

# **Required Supplies**

Laura Heine Teeny Tiny Collage Pattern (your choice)
Fabric Kit or Assorted Fabrics (we will discuss selecting fabrics during class, so you don't need to have all of
them for first class)
Pattern Ease – amount will depend on individual pattern chosen
Steam a Seam 2 (Regular - please do not get "Lite") – amount will depend on individual pattern chosen
Scissors (we strongly recommend Karen K Buckley's Perfect Scissors Medium - Blue handles)
Applique Pressing Sheet (we recommend the Goddess Sheet - on our website)
Pencil

## Optional (not required but nice to have)

Precision Fusing Mat (Optional: for Teeny Tinies and Whatevers
Tray for corralling cuttables
Fabric Fuse Fabric Glue (Optional)Glue pen and/or basting tape
