



Intro to Fabric Collage

Class Description:

Start your journey into fabric collage by starting with a nicely sized collage (about 18" x 24") and learn the basics of Laura Heine's beautiful collage technique while working on your choice from the Teeny Tiny Patterns. (Pattern sold separately) This class will teach you how to put together a collaged front and show you tools and techniques to make the process even more fun.

By the time class is over, you should be close to complete and armed with information on how to finish up with a quilted mini-masterpiece.

Treelotta Class Policies
