Class Description

Intimidated by complex quilt designs? Learn how foundation paper piecing is the tool you want to create perfectly pieced quilts, complex and detailed designs, or designs that are not set on a typical grid.

We will make this cute beehive block in class that you can finish later however you would like. Our sample in the picture was quilted and mounted in an embroidery hoop. We also have a cute tote bag up in the shop that a past class participant made from her block (thank you, Nancy!).

Skill level

Beginner. Participants should be familiar with their sewing machines, basic piecing and sewing accurate 1/4" seams.

What does class fee include?

Class fee covers instructor, facilities costs only. Project supplies need to be purchased separately before class. Kits can be purchased before class or when you come. The free pattern can be downloaded separately. Please note that there may be some prep work to complete so give yourself enough time to do that prior to class.

	Class kits can be purchased before class or when you come.
Supp	lies
	Sewing machine (with power cord, foot pedal, knee left lever (if you have one), etc.)
	Presser foot (regular presser foot is fine, but I like to use my 1/4" presser foot)
	Single stitch plate (if you have one)
	Thread (I prefer a 50wt thread or thinner - the higher the number the thinner the thread is. Also, I would pick a light neutral - like a light tan/beige.)
	Needles (80/12 or 75/11 - the lower the number the thinner the needle is)
	Normal sewing tools (including: thread snips, rotary cutter, pins, Wonder clips - you are welcome to use our cutting mats or bring a small one of your own)
	Add-a-quarter ruler (we'll have these in the shop for sale if you don't have one)
	Glue Pen (we like the Sewline glue pen)
