Class Description:

Get organized in style with **A Place for Everything** by ByAnnie! This spacious, multi-pocket organizer is the ultimate storage solution for sewing supplies, tools, travel items, and more — and now you can make it yourself in this two-part class, following the recommended format from ByAnnie.

In this workshop, you'll work through the bag step by step, learning essential skills like quilting your own fabric with Soft and Stable, working with mesh and vinyl, installing zippers, and creating a professional-looking finish. With its removable pocket pages, sturdy handles, and lots of compartments, this bag lives up to its name!

We'll break the project into manageable stages over two sessions, giving you time to sew, ask questions, and finish strong with confidence.

Supplies:

☐ See pattern for material requirements. FYI:
☐ The pattern calls for 5 yards of 1" polypro strapping, to be covered by "coordinating fabric". You can swap this with other strapping/webbing you wish to be visible, keeping in mind:
☐ The page strap (31.5" of the strapping) needs to be 1" wide, and you will sew the velcro to it
You can use a different width for the rest of the strapping/webbing as long as your hardware size matches your webbing width
\square 2 3 yd of 54" vinyl was plenty for making all the pockets on the "pages"
I used mesh for only the interior pockets of the carrying case, which used only a small amount of one package of mesh
☐ 1/8" basting tape
☐ Denim needle
☐ Highly recommended: stilleto
☐ Thread and all your favorite sewing supplies (snips, pins/clips, marking tool(s) that will be visible on each of your fabrics…)
☐ Your sewing machine in good working order. Bring your zipper foot!
