Reversible Panel Apron Option

*Reversible Apron Option:

*Option: 5/8 yard contrasting fabric to make reversible.

Lay contrasting fabric beneath apron pattern (wrong-sides together). Cut through both layers along apron outline. Cut 2 pairs of pockets and 1 set of ties. Make 2 pairs of pockets (follow direction 2 on the panel). Make only 1 set of ties (follow direction 3 on the panel). Baste neckties 5/8" in from side seam at apron top. Baste waist ties 5/8" below corner of apron waist (this is for seam allowance). Sandwich neck and waist ties in place (all ties should run towards the center of apron) between right-sides of apron pieces. Pin and sew using 5/8" seam allowance around entire apron, leaving 3-4" opening at the bottom center. Be sure to tuck ties towards the center to avoid catching them in your seams. Turn right-side out through opening. Press and top-stitch around apron, reversing over ties several times to secure.
