



Rollie Pollie Bag (Cozy Nest Design) - August 2025 Bag of the Month

Location: Treelotta (In-person attendance is assumed. Please let us know if you plan to join us via Zoom instead.)

Class Description:

*Join us for a fun and creative sewing class where you'll make the **Rollie Pollie Bag** by Cozy Nest Designs! This cleverly designed bag is both cute and practical, featuring a unique cylindrical shape that makes it perfect for organizing everything from toiletries to sewing tools. With its sturdy structure and customizable size options, it's a great project to show off your favorite fabrics*

Skill level: Intermediate.

Please complete before first class:

- **Read** the pattern to familiarize yourself with it and make sure you have all the supplies you need.
- **Test** your sewing machine to make sure it is in working order and you have all the feet needed for this project. Please pack extra needles and bobbins. If not very familiar with your machine, please bring your manual for your reference.
- **Prepare the Pattern.** You can make this in 3 different sizes (w x h x d) – small (8 x 4¾ x 5), medium (9 x 5½ x 5½) and large (10 x 5¾ x 6½). Pick the size you will be making and print the pattern sheets for that size. Print the cutting labels for the size you are making. The sample in the store is a medium.
- **Cut and Prepare ALL** required pieces (under “Prepare the Fabric” on page 4 of the pattern). Make sure all pieces are fused to the interfacing, Heat n Bond, and Foam Stabilizer as detailed in this section.

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Supplies:

- Pattern – Rollie Pollie Organizer from Cozy Nest Design
- Fabric 1 – 2/3 yard (small), 3/4 yard (medium), or 7/8 yard (large)
- Fabric 2 – 2/3 yard (small), 3/4 yard (medium), or 7/8 yard (large)
- Fabric 3 – 3/8 yard (all sizes)
- Medium Weight Fusible Interfacing – 20” wide – 1 5/8 yard (small), 1 3/4 yard (medium), or 2 yards (large)
- Heat n’ Bond Lite – 17” wide -1 5/8 yard (small), 1 7/8 yard (medium), or 2 yards (large)
- Foam Stabilizer – 21½” x 9” (small), 24” x 10” (medium), or 26½” x 11” (large)
- Velcro – ¾” wide – 63” (small), 70” (medium), or 81” (large)
- Zippers – 4 all-purpose or larger – 8” (small), 9” (medium), or 10” (large) – zippers can be longer than required
- D-ring or Grommet for hanger – 1” D-ring or 1 7/8” (small or medium), 1 ¼” (large) grommet.
- Heavy-weight needle
- Temporary marking tool
- Thread to complement fabrics

Tools:

- Sewing machine, (don’t forget your power cord and foot pedal!)
- Feet for your machine – **general purpose foot, zipper foot, and walking foot** (optional)
- Scissors, thread snips, clips, pins

Optional:

- 24” long clear ruler (optional but recommended)
- Fabric glue stick, wonder tape or similar adhesive (optional) for attaching Velcro, zippers, & binding
- Walking foot
- Stiletto
