Supply list:

- Book, Show Me How to Paper Piece by Carol Doak. It would be a good idea to purchase the book and look it over before class.
- Add a Quarter ruler – small size
- 6" or 6 ½" square ruler
- Rotary cutter with sharp blade (45 size or bigger)
- Straight pins with flat head
- Pressing tool
- Fabric glue stick
- Post card or index card
- Thread to blend
- 90/14 needle universal or microtex
- Open toe machine foot
- Sewing machine, foot pedal, cord, manual, and tools. Check your machine, clean, oil (some machines do not require oil), and thread (bobbin, too).

Fabrics:

You can bring coordinating scraps no smaller than 3" squares in light (background) and darks or mediums (heart.) We will be making several to put together to make the little quilt in the book. Check the fabric yardage in the book, page 5 for amount needed for hearts, border, binding, backing, and batting.
