Supplies Needed:

- Sewing machine with ¼ foot, Walking foot, Zig Zag, Zipper and Open toe foot, ditch stitch foot.
- Wonder Clips
- Clover Chaco Liner(marking chalk)or water erasable pen or Frixion pen
- Scissors for cutting zipper tape and small snips to trim threads.
- Rotary cutter
- 1/8 inch double sided tape
- Refer to the back of the pattern or the following page for fabric and notion requirements.

Come in and purchase your pattern before class.

Quilt your Front Panel before class. You can use an orphan quilt block or fabric of your choice to quilt. Your quilted piece of fabric will need to be at least 10"x10".

Cut out or copy and cut out all your pattern pieces.

Quilted Trucker Hat

- Front Panel: 10"x10" Quilted Panel (*preferably quilted with a foam stabilizer*) Outer Shell: ¼ yard or 1 Fat Quarter
- Lining: ¼ yard or 1 Fat Quarter
- ¼ yard Fusible Lightweight interfacing
- ¼ yard Fusible Ultra-Firm Stabilizer
- Snap closures (4 sets)*
- Coordinating 40wt thread

**You can use Post-Style or Sew-In snaps, as an alternative you can use a 3" strip of 5/8" hook & loop tape* Recommended Tools Needed

Tips for fabric selection:

- If you are using an existing quilt that doesn't have much body, you can use some fusible foam stabilizer on the back of the piece
- If working with directional prints, be sure they are facing the correct direction before cutting
- Have fun, try a scrappy version!
