Fabric Requirements

Pond Hockey Centre panel: 1.1 metre

Canada Red Kona Fabric: .5 metre

Skate Border Fabric: 1.2 metre

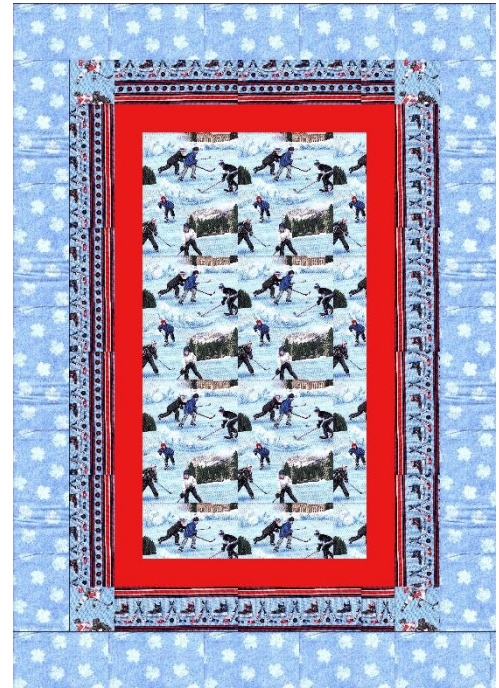
Corner Blocks: .1 metre

Light Blue border: .9 metre

Binding: .25 metre

Cutting Instructions.

1. From the centre panel cut the panel 20 ½" x 38 ½".
2. From the red border fabric cut 5 strips 3" Width of Fabric (WOF). Sub cut 2 strips 20 ½" long and assemble the remaining to measure 43 ½" long.
3. From hockey skate fabric cut four strips 4 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF). Sub cut to make two strips 25 ½" long and two strips 43 ½" long.
4. From the hockey player fabric fussy cut four squares 4 ½" x 4 ½".
5. From the border light blue fabric cut 5 strips 5 1/2" WOF. Assemble end to end the strips to make two strips measuring 43 ½" long and 2 strips measuring 51 ½" long.



Assembling instructions.

1. Sew the two 20 1/2" red border fabric to top and bottom of the centre panel. Press. Sew the remaining two red border strips to each side of the centre panel. Press.
2. Sew the two 43 ½" skate fabric to each side of the red centre. Press.
3. At each end of the remaining skate fabric sew a fussy cut 4 ½" hockey player fabric.
4. Sew these last two skate borders to the top and bottom of the centre quilt matching the seams.
5. Sew the last four light blue borders starting with the two sides and finishing with the top and bottom.
