Introduction

There's nothing scary about this adorable scarecrow door hanger or wall quilt. Lisa will guide you through creating your own scarecrow using a grid interface which makes sewing the squares together really easy!

Fabric Requirements

½ yard backing	3-4 assorted ivory (shirt)
½ fusible fleece or batting of your choice	2 different flesh (face)
1 piece 20" wide of fusible 2" grid	2 different red/orange
(10 two inch squares wide x	(eyes, nose and overalls)
18 two inch squares long)	5 assorted oranges (overalls & hat band)
Fabric kit available , please pre-order before class	4 assorted teals (scarf and hat band)
or you'll need the following (jelly roll pieces, scraps	
or fat quarters will work for this project):	

Notions Needed

Roly Poly Scarecrow Pattern Pak Plus by Happy Hollow Designs which includes the embellishment kit	Microtex sharp needles recommended 80/12 or 90/12
Thread for piecing & matching threads for quilting	Applique pressing sheet
Sewing machine with walking foot	Ironing pad and small iron if you have one for 1 st class only
Pins	Unique Stitch fabric glue
Rotary cutter and acrylic ruler	Point turner of your choice
Water-soluble blue marking pen or Frixion pen	

Class Preparation

Please do not wait till the last day to prep for class! In order to have a productive 1st class, please cut all squares. I recommend cutting extra of each color to have more placement options. **Cut squares 1 7/8"** (below indicates how many squares of each color needed). **Please bring an ironing pad if you have one to 1st class.**

Assorted teals: 24	Assorted browns: 64
Assorted Ivory: 8	Flesh: 24
Assorted oranges: 48	Assorted red/orange: 4

Also: Look at the assembly guide instructions inside the pattern and make half square triangle combinations. These are the combinations of colors needed. Note: The technique shown will only make one half square triangle. Do not try to get two sets of half square triangles from one pair, they will turn out too small.

Flesh/orange: 4	Teal/ivory: 2
Teal/orange: 8	Brown/flesh: 2
