Week 2 - July 9th

Cut 15-1/2" wide strips of fabric x 42" WOF

Single

Queen

Fabric 1: Background - Lightest Cream Fluff

Cut 2 strips

Cut 2 strips

Step 1:

1. Subcut the 15-1/2" x 42" strips, one at a time. The first strip should yield 11 or 12 pcs. Now subcut the second 15-1/2" x 42" strip to get the total number of pieces required for your quilt size - this will leave a section of uncut fabric for Step 2 below.

Subcut strips into 3-1/2" x 15-1/2" pieces.

Cut (14) pcs. Cut (16) pcs.

A 3-1/2" x 15-1/2"

2. Clip or pin these cut pieces together and label **A**. Put in a safe place for later.

Total Vield: Single Size: 14 pcs. Queen Size: 16 pcs.

From the Leftover Fabric:

Step 2: For the Single Size ONLY:


Fabric 1: Background - Lightest Cream Fluff

Leftover fabric piece will measure 15-1/2" wide x at least 29" (or wider) to the selvedge.

- 1. Cut into (4) 3-1/2" x 29" wide strips. Then subcut each strip into 5-1/2" sections to make 3-1/2" x 5-1/2" pcs.
- 2. Clip or pin these cut pieces together and label **B**. Put in a safe place for later.

B 3-1/2" x 5-1/2"

Total Vield: Single Size: 20 pcs.

From the Leftover Fabric:

Step 2: For the Queen Size ONLY:



Fabric 1: Background - Lightest Cream Fluff

Leftover fabric piece will measure 15-1/2" wide x at least 23" (or wider) to the selvedge.

- 1. Cut into (4) 3-1/2" x 23" wide strips. Then subcut each strip into 5-1/2" sections to make 3-1/2" x 5-1/2" pcs.
- 2. Clip or pin these cut pieces together and label B. Put in a safe place for later.

Total Yield: Queen Size: 16 pcs.
