## Week 3 - July 16th

Cut 4" wide strips of fabric x 42" WOF
$\square$

Fabric 3: Frosty Cream
Fabric 7 : Med. Light Smokey Gray
Cut 3 strips Cut 4 strips


1. Subcut each strip into $4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Cut 24 pcs. Cut 32 pcs.
2. Keeping 'same fabric' pieces together, subcut each 4" square twice diagonally.


Cut: Single Size: 96 pcs. Queen Size: 128 pcs.

## Step 2:

1. Join one cut triangle from each fabric together to make a half-square triangle. Press seam towards Fabric 7 as shown by the red arrow.


Now the following instructions I KNOW many of you are going to be whining over...but please, just bear with me on this.
Trimming: Align the 45-degree ruler markings along the diagonal seam of the unit, while also lining up the 2-1/4" markings at the corners. Trim one side and top, turn unit, align ruler and trim remaining side and top side. This unit should now measure perfectly.
2. These half-square triangles are larger than we need. They MUST be trimmed to size. Trim each unit to measure $2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished
 size.

Make: Single Size: 96 pcs. Queen Size: 128 pcs.

Happy Note: You will not require any more Fabric 3 or Fabric 7.

## For best use of the fabric, please follow the specific cutting instructions for the quilt size that you are making.

Step 3: For the Single Size ONLY
Single
Cut 3-1/2" wide strips of fabric x 42" WOF
$\square$ Fabric 4 : Misty Morning

Cut 3 strips

1. Subcut each strip into $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sections to make pieces that will measure $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.
2. Clip or pin these cut pieces together and label $\mathbf{C}$. Put in a safe place for later.

Step 3: For the Queen Size ONLY
Cut 5-1/2" wide strips of fabric $\times 42^{\prime \prime}$ WOF

$\square$Fabric 4 : Misty Morning

1. Subcut each strip into $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sections to make pieces that will measure $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.
2. Clip or pin these cut pieces together and label $\mathbf{C}$. Put in a safe place for later.

C $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

Cut: Queen Size: 24 pcs.

Happy Note: You will not require any more Fabric 4.
And...I did forget to mention from Week 1, you will not require any more Fabric 2 or Fabric 6 , as well!
