Week 7 - August 13th

Last week's work assignment may carry over to this week. You have some time, as planned, so keep assembling those units before proceeding with this week's work.

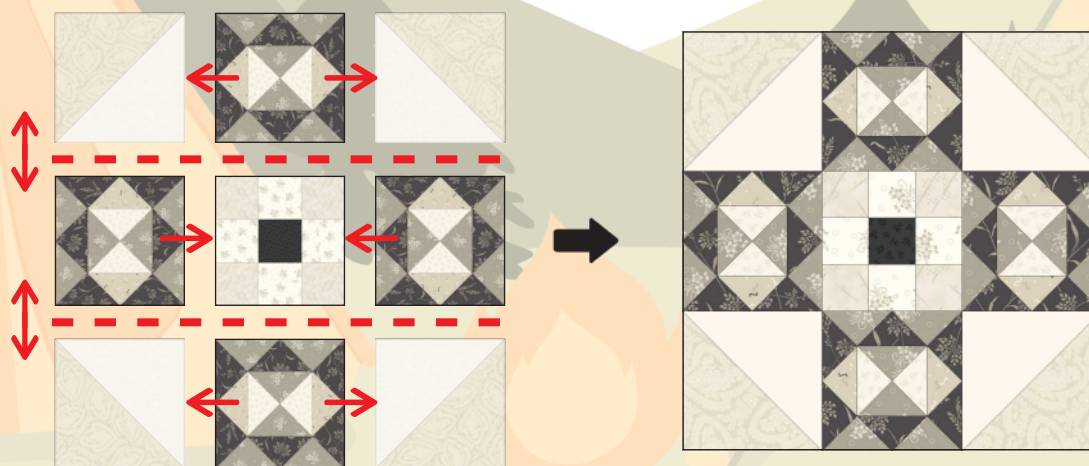
Gather the units from the following weeks:

	<u>Single</u>	<u>Queen</u>
 From Week 1	12 pcs.	16 pcs.
 From Week 1	48 pcs.	64 pcs.
 From Week 6	48 pcs.	64 pcs.

1. Refer to the diagram below and carefully layout the units to form the 'Adventure' block as shown. Double check the position of the unit from Week 6 - it is a tricky one, and no one wants a date with 'Jack the ripper'!

Please Note: Diagrams below do NOT show seam allowance. Do not trim to match diagrams.

2. Working in horizontal rows, join the units together matching the corner seams, watch that the points from Week 6 do not get chopped off. Finger press seam as shown by the red arrows.
3. Now carefully join the rows together to form the block, nesting and matching seams and watching those points. Finger press seam open as shown and gently press with the iron.
4. This 'Adventure' block should now measure 15-1/2" x 15-1/2" unfinished. Allow for the 1/4" seam allowance and trim to tidy edges, keeping points 1/4" away from the raw edge.



Make: Single Size: 12 pcs. Queen Size: 16 pcs.
