

# Cinnamon Swirl Workshop

**Finished quilt top:** Table Runner: 36" x 66" & Quilt Size: 72" x 72"

**Experience Level:** Intermediate

100% cotton fabrics are recommended

## About This Quilt Design

**Pattern:** BCS 1135 Cinnamon Swirl

Reminiscent of cinnamon candies available at holiday time this block makes my mouth water for that yummy flavour – one of my favourites.

Although I have made this quilt using the seasonal colours of Christmas (red, green and cream) this quilt design would look equally stunning in any fabric colourway or even a different fabric feel i.e. batiks or reproduction fabrics for example.

## Fabric Requirements for Workshop:

You do not have to bring the fabric required for the entire quilt to the workshop. If you would like to do samples of the work taught in the workshop, you may bring an assortment of fabrics to work from, to practice and play.

The fabric requirements for the entire quilt (BCS 1135 Cinnamon Swirl are on page 2 but are not a requirement for the workshop. If you wish to bring what you plan to use for the quilt, please do so.

Bring the following:

Block Background – Cream tonal:		Total
<b>For either quilt size:</b>	Cut (1) strip 13-1/2" x 42" WOF. Subcut into 13-1/2" x 13-1/2" pcs.	3 pcs.
And the following:		
<b>For the Swirl &amp; Sashing Shown as red and cream</b>	Please bring a Fat ¼ or more of each.	
<b>For the Circle: shown as green</b>	Please bring a Fat ¼ or more.	
<b>For samples of the border: Shown as red, green, cream</b>	Please bring a Fat ¼ or more of each. (Note: can use the same fabrics as above)	



## Supplies & Tools:

- ✓ Sewing machine in good working order that is able to do a blanket stitch or a zig-zag (including power cords and extension cords) and don't forget your: a) 1/4" piecing foot and b) For applique bring an Open toe embroidery foot - as shown or a zigzag foot.
- ✓ A sharp machine needle at least a size 80/12.
- ✓ Scissors, seam ripper, pins and any other notions you usually sew with.
- ✓ Rotary cutter, mat and rulers. If you keep secondary scissors to use on paper please bring them.
- ✓ A fine permanent pen for tracing appliqué shapes.



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- ✓ Thread (colour matched to your three fabrics for the 'swirl' i.e. red, green, cream), scissors, seam ripper, pins and any other notions you usually sew with.
- ✓ Heat'n Bond or similar type of iron on fusible that you are able to trace right onto the product. If you do not have any, I will be bringing some to class for purchase.
- ✓ A light box – IF you have one. Please do not purchase one especially to bring to class.
- ✓ Individual mini irons if they are approved for your venue, unless you are okay to share at any pressing stations provided. Please check with the workshop coordinator we wouldn't want to blow the fuses!
- ✓ **I will provide:** The pattern *BCS 1135 Cinnamon Swirl* is included with your workshop fee and will be supplied to you on the day of the workshop. If you already own one, please bring it with you to the workshop.

**Fabric Requirements for the Entire Quilt:**

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Quantities specified are for 44/45" wide fabrics.  
100% Cotton or Cotton Flannels are recommended.

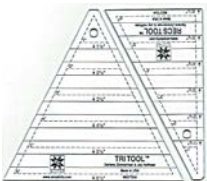
<b>Light Cream Snowflake Tonal Fabric</b>	Blocks, Sashing, Borders	0.9m or 1 yd. 3.0m or 3-1/4 yds.
<b>Cream Gold Flecked Fabric</b>	Blocks, Border	1 0.8m or 7/8 yd. 1.5m or 1-2/3 yds.
<b>Dark Green Print Fabric</b>	Blocks, Border 3	0.9m or 1 yd. 1.9m or 2 yds.
<b>Red Berries Tonal Fabric</b>	Blocks, Sashing	0.5m or 1/2 yd. 1.2m or 1-1/4 yds.
<b>Red Gold Flecked Fabric</b>	Blocks	0.3m or 3/8 yd. 0.6m or 5/8 yd.
<b>Binding:</b> Red Berries Tonal Fabric		0.5m or 1/2 yds. 0.7m or 2/3 yds.
Heat n' Bond Fusible or similar product for applique		1.3m or 1-1/2 yds. 3.5m or 4 yds

**Additional Tools:**

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I will be demonstrating these tools listed below. If you have them please bring them, if you don't, please do not feel the need to purchase them for the workshop. Why? Because you may not like them and having the opportunity to play with them first allows you to see what they are all about before purchasing.

Please bring this type or similar ruler if you have one.  
For construction of the Sashing Stars, we will be using:



- ✓ Either the EZ Quilting Tri-Recs™ Tools or V Block™ ruler from Deb Tucker's Studio 180 Design or similar type ruler that will construct the makes the 'Peaky & Spike' block.
