

# Bear Floor Rug Supply List

This class will offer two finishing options for the nose, ears, and paws: chenille and quilt. Choose one of the finishes.

**Required:** Bear Floor Pattern

**Materials:**

- 50 – 2 ½" x 42" strips of assorted fabrics
- 60 yards of 2 ¼ inch precut fusible batting  
    Or 3 packs of 45" x 60" fusible batting (to be cut into 2 ¼ " x 45" strips)
- ½ yard of fabric for binding
- Fat quarter for inner paw, nose, and eyes
- Chenille: 1 ½ yards of fabric for the nose, ears, and paws  
    3/8 yard of dark contrast fabric for the nose, ears, and paws
- Quilt: 3/4 yards of fabric for the nose, ears, and paws  
    13 ½ x 42 piece of batting for the nose, ears, and paws

**Sewing Equipment:**

- Polyester thread
- Tube maker options are The Gypsy Tube Maker, the Clover Fabric Tube Maker, or the Jelly Roll Sasher (I used the Clover Fabric Tube Maker)
- For the chenille finish, a chenille rotary cutter is required
- For the chenille finish, a chenille brush
- Sharp scissors
- Roxanne Glue Baste-it
- Sewing machine
- A ¼ inch foot is helpful
- A walking foot is helpful
- Standard sewing supplies

**Before Class:**

If you purchased the 45" x 60" of fusible batting, cut 50 - 2 ¼" x 45" strips
