Easy Applique--- Mr. & Mrs. Cardinal Collage Workshop~ With Pauline

1 yd. Steam-A- Seam 2 (2-sided paper) (no substitutes)

Applique pressing sheet (plastic, to build collage)

Iron, ironing mat, pressing sheet to protect iron from fusible web

Scotch tape

Tracing Paper- 2 to 3 sheets

Pencil and sharpener

Paper scissors

Paper/fabric scissors

Straight pins

Black Sharpe-thin line

Lunch and drink

Fabric:

Batik fabrics are my preferred choice for fusible raw-edge applique as it does not fray like regular cotton fabric.

5 to 8 reds- 6-inch squares for cardinals' bodies (light to dark, shades of red to reddish-orange)

3 to 4 – 6-inch squares of medium to dark tans for female cardinal's body

- 1-- 5-inch square black for cardinals' face
- 1-- 3-inch square of both a medium and a dark orange for the cardinals' beak
- 1-- 8 by 2-inch rectangle of white for snow
- 1-- 8 by 4-inch rectangle of brown for branches
- 1-- 8-inch square of green for pine needles
- 1 fat quarter background for sky
- 1 fat quarter for backing
- 1 fat quarter of thin cotton batting

Homework: fuse the backs of the reds, black, white, brown, green, and tans fabrics before class. Do not remove the second paper on the back of the fabric.

I will have a black and white pattern of the Mr. & Mrs. Cardinal on the day of the class.

Additional Supplies you may need: We probably will not get to the quilting, just in case....

Rotary cutter with a new sharp blade, cutting mat and ruler

Sewing Machine: able to free-motion quilt

Threads for quilting

Bobbins

Machine Quilting-Mircotex or Topstitch needles 90/14
