Quilting with Rulers on Your Domestic Machine With Pauline

Supply list:

1. Domestic Sewing machine -clean and in good working order & <u>able to</u> <u>do free-motion quilting with the feed dogs down.</u> Don't' forget your manual.

- 2. Sewing machine extension table it will give you extra flat surface.
- 3. Sew Steady ruler foot to work with your machine
- 4. Westalee Sew Steady 12" Arc template
- 5. Westalee Sew Steady 6-piece quilting template rule-1 set
- 6. Quality Thread one spool of dark colored thread recommended threads Aurifil 40 wt., Superior Threads King Tut, So Fine!.
- 7. Quality Sewing Machine needle -Schmetz Top Stitch needle or Microtex sharp needle 90/14
- 8. Free Motion Glider or Sew Slip

9. 1 fine tip air/water disappearing marking pen - test on fabric before using

10. A ruler that is 3 inches \times 12 inches OR 6 inches \times 24 inches

- 11. Westalee Sew Steady ruler spacing gauge
- 12. Westalee Sew Steady Crosshair ruler 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches
- 13. Thread stand (optional)
- 14. Quilting Gloves or bands (optional)

15. Fabric.....

Solid fabric light to medium: Prep - Either make 6 practice quilt sandwiches about 12 + inches X 12 + inches to practice stitching OR 1 fabric sandwich 22 inches X 36 inches. Baste with basting spray or use fusible batting. Pin basting will be problematic for ruler work and freemotion.

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
