

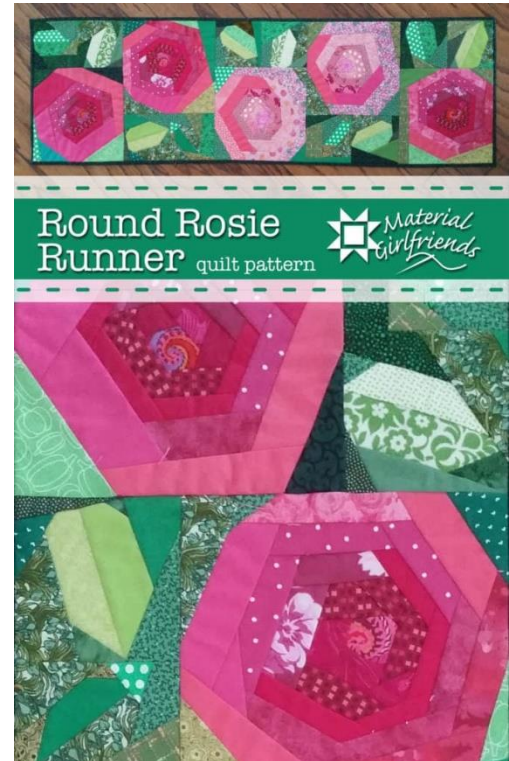
## Round Rosie Runner Class

Table Runner 12" x 40"

This beautiful table runner pattern requires no paper-piecing nor foundation piecing and is scrap friendly. The class will cover how to create this table runner, and the pattern includes additional instructions from Crib to King should you wish to create a larger piece.

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### Fabric Requirements:

For Rosies: *I found using 7 fabrics per rosie worked best, however having 8-10 fabrics of varying values of one color will provide you some fun options. Consider using one fabric for your rosie centers that is a vibrant medium value.*

- 1/8<sup>th</sup> yard of 8-10 fabrics for rosies including several values of one color (dark to medium-light)
- 1/8<sup>th</sup> yard of 8-10 green fabrics for the leaves and background
- 1/2 yard for backing
- 1/4 yard for binding

### Supply List:

- Round Rosie Runner pattern by Material Girlfriends (*available at Blue Hen Quilt Shop*)
- Sewing machine you are familiar with that is in good working order
- 1/4 inch foot
- Cutting mat, straight ruler and rotary cutter
  - o 8 1/2 inch square ruler (or larger) is also helpful but not required
- Basic sewing supplies such as; scissors, seam ripper, thread, bobbins, etc.
