

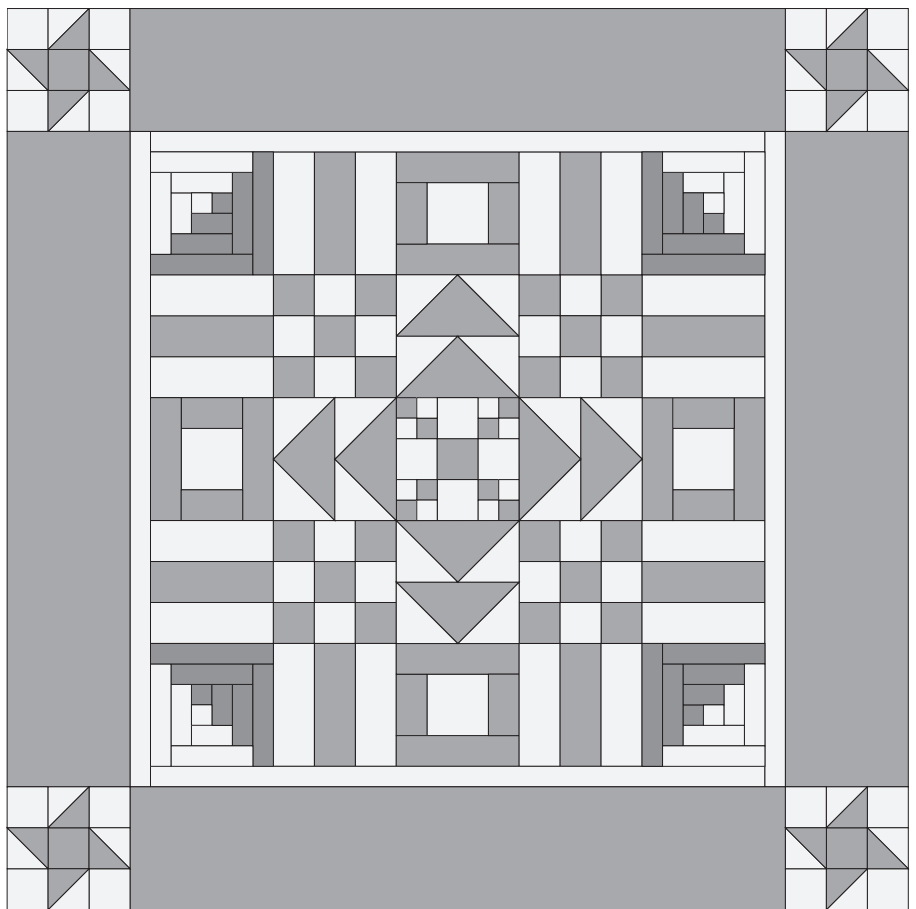

In this class you will learn the basics of choosing fabrics, rotary cutting your fabrics, sewing accurate seams, correct fabric piecing techniques, putting a quilt top together, sandwiching.

Basic machine quilting and binding will be addressed on the last day.

We will make a "Sampler" quilt that highlights many different piecing techniques. The first day we will learn to use the rotary cutter and sew an accurate 1/4" seam. In the second class, most of the blocks will be pieced. The quilt top will come together, borders and all, in the third class and the last class will be focused on quilting and binding. You can do it!!

45 mm Rotary Cutter
6-1/2 x 24-1/2" ruler
Straight pins
Scissors and/or thread snips
Seam Ripper
Sewing Machine (know how to use it please)
Walking foot for machine quilting,
1/4" presser foot VERY helpful
We will discussing other items during class.

Outer Border	1
Background and inner border	1-3/4
3 cordinating fabrics	5/8 of each
Backing fabric	1-3/4
Binding	3/8
Batting	Throw 60" x 60"
