## **CADDY PAD**

## Supplies:

- <u>Caddy Pad</u> pattern (available @ Blue Hen Quilt Shop).
- (2) 21" x 28" pieces of Insul-Bright (available @ Blue Hen Quilt Shop).
- (1) 11 3/4" x 5 1/2" template, made from cardboard or template plastic. ACCURACY COUNTS!
- (1) yd webbing (cotton or poly).
- Fabric -
  - Main Fabric (MF) 21" x 28" (I STRONGLY SUGGEST A NON-DIRECTIONAL FABRIC). This needs to be pre-shrunk.
  - Handles Can match binding, main fabric or contrast. Directions call for (2) 4" x 14" pieces. I cut mine 5" x 20" as I found the first set of handles to be too short.
  - 1/4 yd for binding (either 2-1/4 inch or 2-1/2 inch). About 90 inches of binding is suggested.
- (2) 1" or larger coordinated buttons (shank buttons work well).
- 9" 1/4"-wide elastic.
- Sewing Machine in good working order.
- Walking Foot.
- 1/4" foot.
- Matching thread; pre-wound bobbins.
- Rotary Cutter, Blade and Mat.
- Straight Pins
- Scissors.

## \*\*\*PRE-CLASS PREP\*\*\*

- 1. Make template (be accurate)
- 2. Cut main fabric and 2 layers of Insul-Bright (21" x 28")
- 3. Make binding.
