

CURVALICIOUS WALL HANGING OR TABLE RUNNER CLASS SUPPLY LIST

Learn to use the exciting Curvalicious ruler, a technique that makes quick but complicated looking quilts.

Supplies (all available at *Blue Hen Quilt Shop*):

- Curvalicious ruler, by OyVey Quilt Designs (Cheryl Lynch)
- 6, 1/4 yard pieces of coordinating fabrics: one for narrow border, 2 for background (dark purple and blue on pattern), 3 for other curvy strips
- 1/2 yard backing fabric
- 1/3 yard for binding (we might not get to this point in class)
- Batting: about 16" x 45"
- 1 1/4 yard paper backed fusible web (such as Heat-n-Bond light or Steam a Seam)
- Pressing mat/sheet for fusing appliqué
- 28mm rotary cutter with new sharp blade. A larger blade will not work on the curves
- Cutting mat, 24" x 18"
- Straight rotary ruler, 6"x 24"
- Threads for quilting, colorful or blending
- *Sewing machine in good working order and sewing knowledge and skills with same machine (remember your power cords!)*
- *Usual sewing supplies: 1/4" foot, threads, scissors, seam ripper, pins...*
- *Walking foot, free motion (darning foot) for quilting*

Before class:

Using the 3 fabrics that will be the curvy strips, cut a 4" by WOF (width of fabric) strip from each one. Bring the leftover fabric to class for circles.

Cut 3 strips of fusible web at 3 7/8" wide by 44". Following the directions that come with your fusible web, fuse the web, leaving the paper intact, to the wrong side of the 4" fabric strips. Other cutting and circle fusing will be done in class.
