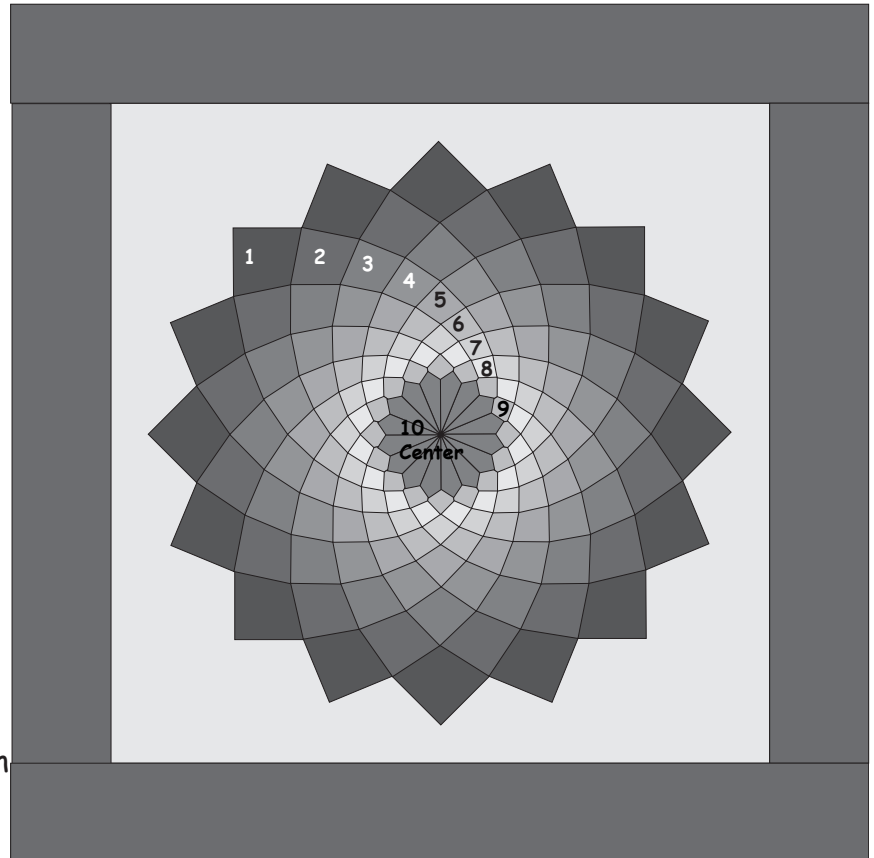

### Supplies Needed:

- Dahlia Delight pattern \$9 (available from Erin in the workshop)
- 24" ruler, Rotary Cutter and Mat
- Creative Grids 22.5 degree Triangle Ruler (\$28.50 available from Erin) or template plastic (templates included in pattern)
- Basic Sewing Supplies, 1/4" Foot
- Thread to match each fabric for top stitching
