

Rainbow Strings

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Supply List

Fabric:

Pre-wash all fabric, including muslin foundation.

Purchase **Rainbow Strings** pattern by Madge Ziegler. Decide which size you are going to make and purchase fabrics as listed on the back of the pattern. The choice of accent fabric is critical. Read through the pattern for suggestions.

NOTE: You may come with your foundations, accent fabric and strings cut. That will give you a big head start. Cutting instructions are in the pattern. At least try and have the 9" muslin foundation squares cut.

Supplies:

- Neutral thread for sewing machine.
- Sewing machine in working order with two bobbins wound, don't forget the cord, the manual and the extension table if you have one.
- Fabric scissors
- Rotary cutter, long ruler and board. I use an 8 ½" rotary square for trimming the blocks and a 9" or larger square for cutting the foundations. If you come with the foundations, strings and accent fabric cut, you will only need the 8 ½" square for trimming. I use my spinning rotary mat for trimming the squares.
- Iron and board if you don't want to share.
- Glue stick and straight pins
- Basic machine sewing supplies, especially a seam ripper.
- Cushion or quilt to sit on for proper chair height (a phone book will work, too)
