## **Supply List:**

- Sewing machine you are familiar with that is in good working order
- 1/4 inch foot and a zipper foot
- Cutting Mat, Straight Ruler (2 1/2 x 10" or longer) and Rotary Cutter
- coordinating Thread and Bobbins
- hand sewing needle and thimble (if you use one)
- Basic sewing supplies like pins or wonder clips, scissors, seam ripper, etc.
- Stitchery-Doo Pattern

Everything you need is available at Blue hen Quilt Shop!

NOTE: The following fabric requirements vary slightly from what is listed on the pattern.

- one fat quarter for Main Fabric
- one fat quarter for Lining Fabric
- 12" x 14" piece of fusible fleece or other stiff fusible interfacing
- 5" x 15" piece (or three 5" squares) of medium weight fusible interfacing
- 13" or longer zipper of coordinating color

We found this pattern needed additional instructions to sew in the round lid and bottom of the kit, so we have written some and will provide them during the class. A circle template is required to make the lid and bottom of the kit, these templates will also be provided during the class.
