

## TREE HUGGER PILLOW

A wonderful pillow for the entire winter.

Learn machine appliqué, and how to make and apply cording.

Supplies\* (for class):

- Tree fabrics: 5 pieces 6 1/2" x 10 1/2"
- Trunk fabric: one piece 2" x 6"
- Background: 1/2 yard
- Backing: 1/2 yard
- Interior pillow case: 1 yard (something that will not show through your background fabric. Any cotton is fine.
- Cording cover: a fat quarter (we will cut on the bias)
- Cording: Cable cord, 9/32", 2 1/2 yards
- Fusible: Heat n Bond Lite- 1 yard
- Fusible fleece or batting: 15" x 29"
- Thread for piecing, and decorative threads for appliqué around trees
- 30 degree ruler
- Straight ruler, about 6" x 24"
- Cutting mat (18" x 24") and rotary cutter with sharp blade
- Sewing machine in good working order and basic sewing knowledge with same machine (remember your power cords!)
- Usual sewing supplies: **Zipper foot or cording foot**, a "purple thang" or stiletto, 1/4" foot, threads, scissors, pins...

**Before class:** Please fuse your Heat n Bond (or similar fusible) to the wrong side of the fabric for the trees and the trunk strip. Cut 6" x 10" rectangles for the trees and 1 3/4" x 5 3/4" strip for the trunks. Center the fusible on the fabric. Do not trim. Only fuse.
