
Triple Dresden Tree Skirt

Supplies Needed:

Triple Dresden Tree Skirt Pattern Creative Grids 15-Degree Triangle Ruler 24" long ruler for cutting strips Rotary Cutter and Mat Basic Sewing Supplies, Walking-foot or Even-Feed foot Thread to match

Fabric Requirements:

Outer and Inner Dresdens (reds)	The cover quilt used 6 different reds - 1/3 yard each, or you can use one fabric - 1-1/2 yards <i>Class Prep: Cut one 9" strip x width of fabric (WOF) from each color.</i>
Middle Dresden (Green)	The cover quilt used 6 different fat quarters of greens, or you can use one fabric - 3/4 yards <i>Class Prep: Cut one 9" strip from each color. If using one color, cut two 9" strips.</i>
Backing	1-3/4 yards - If a scrappy backing is desired to make it reversible, you will need a 21" x 7" piece for each fan blade - there are 24. Class Prep: Cut one 21" strip x (WOF) if using one color. If a scrappy backing is desired to make it reversible, you will need at least a 21" x 7" piece for each fan blade. There are 24 blades.
Batting	Crib size 45" x 60"
BIAS Binding	30" by 2-1/4"
